- 8. To introduce students to a variety of activities which encourage them to develop morally, physically, socially, academically, emotionally and spiritually.





ACE School Health Screenings October 2-6, 2023

School health screenings are required for hearing, vision, dental and height and weight. Protocols for student and staff safety are provided through the DHHS School Health Program recommendations. Screenings are conducted for grades 1, 2, 3, 4, Pre-School, 5th grade students new from out of state, and KG students missing required health information. Any student may be excused from hearing, vision or dental screening if the parent brings a signed statement from a physician, PA or APRN stating that the child has had these screenings done in the past 6 months. Height and weight screening may be refused if the parent brings to school a signed and dated statement of refusal.

Please do not call for screening results. You will be notified by a referral letter if further evaluation by a specialist is indicated.

Please make sure if students require correction for vision that they have eye glasses or contact lenses with them for the Health Screens.
